

ARTISAN DEPOT JURYING POLICY

Jurying for prospective members takes place on the **first Tuesday** of the month at our monthly Gallery Meeting. Voting will take place by members present.

On the week **prior** to the Gallery Meeting artist must bring in 5 pieces representative of the work they wish to display in the gallery, for each medium. Work will be left in the storage room with name, address and phone number of the artist. Artist should provide a list including descriptions and prices brought in for jurying.

Artist may provide information about themselves and their work if they wish. Worker must leave message in Log Sheet for Gallery Coordinator, informing them we have a prospective member.

Diana Lamb will notify artist of acceptance or decline into the gallery. If accepted Diana will inform new member of policies regarding display/hanging of art.

All wall art must be prepared for hanging with sturdy frame, glass (when applicable) and wire on the back for work subject to damage such as watercolors etc. Canvases do not need to be framed, but sides should be painted, with wire on back to hang. 3-D objects or craft items may need a proper display.
